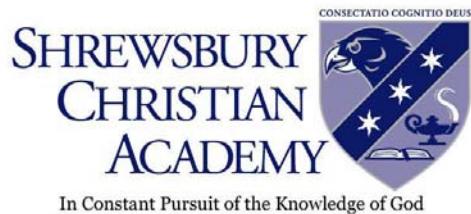


Admissions Policy

Directions

From York and North

Head South on Route 83.
Take exit #4 Shrewsbury.
Turn left end of ramp onto Route 851 heading East.
Go one mile, make Right onto Windy Hill Road.
Stay on Windy Hill for 1.5 miles.
SCA is on the left.

From Stewartstown

Head West on 851 about 4 miles.
Turn left onto Windy Hill Road.
Stay on Windy Hill for 1.5 miles.
SCA is on the left.

From Glen Rock

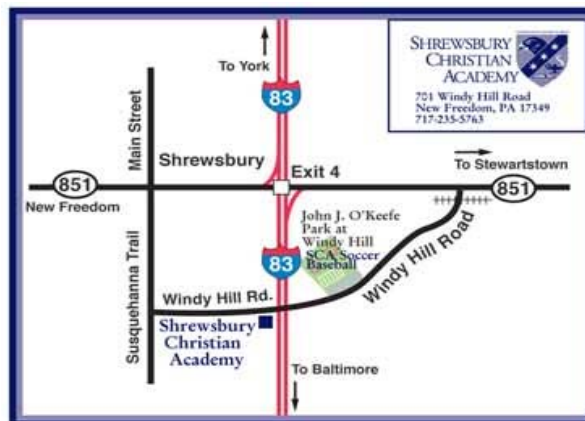
Take the Susquehanna Trail South.
Go through Shrewsbury.
Make a left onto Windy Hill Road.
Stay on Windy Hill for 0.7 miles.
SCA is on the right.

From Maryland and South

Head North on Route 83.
Take exit #4 Shrewsbury.
Turn right end of ramp onto Route 851 heading East.
Go one mile, make Right onto Windy Hill Road.
Stay on Windy Hill for 1.5 miles.
SCA is on the left.

From Parkton

If starting in Maryland, take MD 45/York Rd. North.
Go 3 miles from MD/PA line.
Make a Right onto Windy Hill Road.
Stay on Windy Hill for 0.7 miles.
SCA is on the right.
